Nita Cherry is Professor of Leadership in the Australian Graduate School of Entrepreneurship, Swinburne University of Technology, Melbourne, Australia. She has over 35 years' experience combining the roles of senior executive, management consultant, director, practising psychologist, educator, and researcher. She has worked in both the private, public sectors and not-for-profit sectors.

For most of the past 35 years he has been a practitioner and academic.
